Huntington Meats hosts Kids Pajama Drive for the holidays

Huntington Meats and Farmers Market Poultry at the Original Farmers Market are holding their third Holiday Kids Pajama Drive throughout November to make sure children in need have fresh pajamas this holiday season.

Owner and pajama drive organizer Jim Cascone said the goal is to collect 300 pairs of pajamas for distribution to local agencies serving homeless and low-income



families.

Customers who visit either of the shops and donate a pair of new, unwrapped pajamas valued at \$10 or more will receive a complimentary pound of ground beef or homemade sausages from Huntington Meats, or a dozen fresh eggs from Farmers Market Poultry. In addition to pajamas for children ages infant to 18, the shops will collect children's slippers, robes, security blankets, story books and toothbrush/toothpaste sets through Nov. 30. At the conclusion of the Pajama Drive, the items will be distributed to Los Angeles area agencies for gift giving to their youngest clientele during the holiday season.

"Going on year three, we felt this was a unique idea for the holidays," Cascone said. "Toy drives are great, but we forget that some kids may never have received a brand new pair of PJs, which was something many of us took for granted growing up."

"Our goal is to try make nights a little comfier for those kids that may be experiencing homelessness or are members of a family that just doesn't have the means to purchase their little ones new pajamas," head butcher Jon Escobedo added. "We want to do our part to make sure that kids in need across Los Angeles have new pajamas to snuggle in this holiday season."
